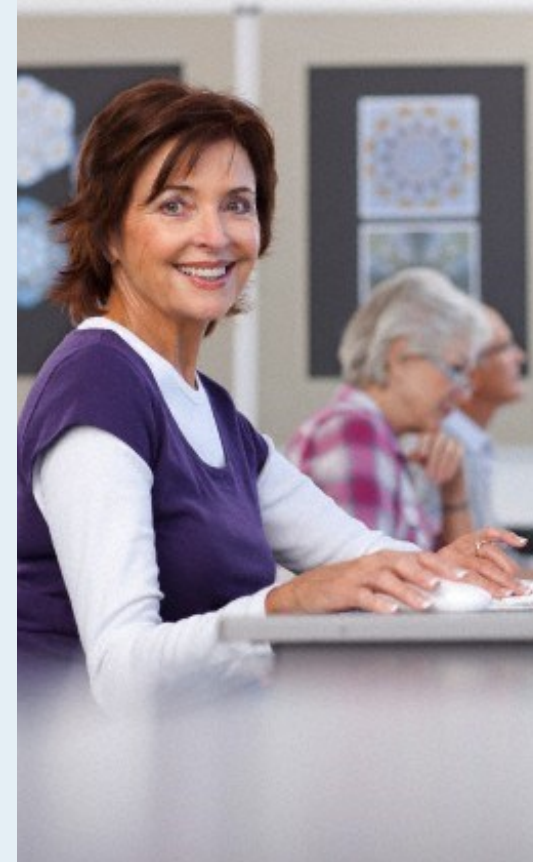
OVERVIEW
